CRITERIA

The Eastern MA Chapter of the National Association of the Remodeling Industry (EM NARI) will award a scholarship to a secondary school graduating senior who has committed to entering a career in the remodeling industry. The criteria used for selection may include, but is not limited to, academic achievement, community involvement and the general essay from the application.

The scholarship money is intended to be used for necessities related to entering a career in the remodeling industry. Candidates may only apply for one scholarship (either the EM NARI Scholarship designated for a child of a NARI member, or the EM NARI TRADE Scholarship, but not both).

Award decisions made by the panel of judges are final.

- School transcript
- Activity profile or separate resume
- General essay (250 words or less)
- Two letters of recommendation, (1) Teacher & (1) Personal or Employer)
- Signed Affidavit attesting commitment to enter the profession upon graduation (see last page).

Please put "EM NARI Scholarship" as the subject of the email. All applications must be postmarked or emailed no later than midnight on Friday, May 1st, 2020 and must contain all requested information. Late/incomplete packages are automatically disqualified. Awardee(s) will be notified in early May 2020. Award presented on June 3rd, 2020.
